

4 Door Neck Instructions

1. Lay Neck across top of jeep.
2. Attach the front 2" Velcro straps through the freedom top bars/lock downs and match them up with the Velcro.
3. Loosely attach front three straps over both sides of the front seats. The straps go under the roll bar, through the billet slide, and back down to the Velcro
4. Repeat for the passenger section, but remember, keep them loose to start with.
5. Before you repeat the same procedure for the rear sections, run the polished billet bar through the bottom loops and into the holes provided by jeep.
6. Now you can attach the rear area straps, just like the mid straps and the front straps.
7. Now comes the fun part. Work your way across the front three straps, pulling them firm. Now do the same to the other side.
8. Repeat step 7 for the middle section
9. Repeat step 7 for the rear area. The rear area straps must not interfere with the seat belt, and must go underneath the seat belt straps.
10. I now like to go back to each strap and pull as hard as I can, all 18 of them.

Side Curtain instructions

1. Undo the rear neck straps completely, one side at a time.
2. I like to start with the bottom rear strap first. Slide the neck billet slide through the strap, and then loosely attach just as you would in the above instructions.
3. Repeat for the other four straps.
4. The bottom part of the side curtains has a grommet/hole in it and a spring loaded clip. This clip will secure the side curtain to the jeep.
5. Pull back the carpet and mark a spot where you are going to drill a 1/2" hole into the metal. It is better to drill when it's loose, so when you attach the clip you can now tighten the top neck straps. Once the hole is drilled, put carpet back in place and cut a small 1"x1" hole in the carpet so that you can attach the clip.
6. Now you can tighten the 5 neck straps.
7. Repeat for other side curtain.

Grocery Organizer.

1. Loosely attach the top part of the grocery organizer to the billet bar
2. Lay the Velcro bottom piece across the floor directly under where the straps fall. Attach the bottom of the Velcro straps to the bottom Velcro piece. You want the grocery organizer to have the bottom straps velcroed toward the inside of the jeep, that way, when you need to set things in the jeep, they simply push away. If they are facing toward you and out of the jeep, then you have to undo each strap, put things into the jeep, then redo each strap. Its much easier the other way around, and works much better keeping things inside the rear of the jeep.
3. Tighten the top straps, but not too tight, just taught.
